Be a part of an historic moment in Niagara Falls! Witness the Olympic Flame as it travels through our City on its way to the Vancouver 2010 Winter Olympics. This is a once-in-a-lifetime experience and we are encouraging you, along with your family and friends, to “Cheer on the Flame!”

There are three ways to participate on Sunday, December 20th:

- **Come out with your family, friends and neighbours and line the route on Sunday, December 20th around 5:30 pm. The Relay will move quickly once it starts at 6:00 p.m., so it's important to find a place to cheer the flame early. We are encouraging a great show of support for the Olympic Flame including Canadian spirit, positive signs, cheering and lots of red and white!**
- **If your school is participating along the Relay Route, be a part of your school's Torch Relay group. Make signs, paint your face, light up the night!**
- **Join us at the free Olympic Torch Relay Celebration at Table Rock Complex running from 5:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Everyone is invited! This is sure to be a phenomenal event as families, students, groups, and the entire community celebrates this important stop on the way to the Olympics.**

The Celebration features:

- ★ **Free event featuring the Falls illuminated with the Olympic colours and a spectacular fireworks display.**
- ★ **Ice sculptures and buskers**
- ★ **Interactive fun and giveaways by RBC and Coca-Cola**
- ★ **Rink at the Brink will be open for free public skating and rentals from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.**
- ★ **Aerial trampoline show featuring acrobatics on skis and snowboards**
- ★ **Performances by the international acclaimed Canadian Tenors, Justin Hines, Chorus Niagara, Niagara Star Singers, Niagara Children's Choir, Red Star Singers and Dancers from the Niagara Regional Native Centre, YouTube sensation Canadian, Please, and local francophone talent Xprime.**

On Monday, December 21st, the Flame will travel by torchbearer starting at 7:45 a.m. along River Road and through the Chippawa area of Niagara Falls.
