The Vancouver Olympic Organizing Committee will be announcing the Route in its entirety only a few days in advance of the Relay event.

Shortly after the Olympic Torch Convoy passes by your location, a Shuttle Bus will arrive to transport your members to the Celebration Site at Table Rock so that your group will be able to enjoy the entertainment, partake in the activities planned, and watch the last Torchbearer light the cauldron at 7:00 p.m. The festivities will end with fireworks over the Falls. This will be our opportunity to shine for Niagara Falls and Canada!

When the event at Table Rock is over, transportation will be available to transport you back to the area along the route where you began.
